

SUBJECT: **Agenda Item 8A – MCA 2009-70100; Municipal Code Amendment to Modify the Oak Tree Ordinance, Oak Tree Preservation and Protection Guidelines, and to Establish a New Application Filing Fee.**


This memorandum clarifies the recommendation presented as Alternative 2 in the February 23, 2010 staff report. Because there were five options identified and analyzed in the Staff Report, it was necessary that the text of the recommendation accommodate whichever of the options that Council selected.

As described on Page 6 of the staff report (packet page 6, as well), if Council elects to provide an exemption for owner-planted oak trees, then Staff recommends selecting **Option 2** (simple permit procedure to determine if oak tree is owner-planted and, if so, establish on-going exemption).
