

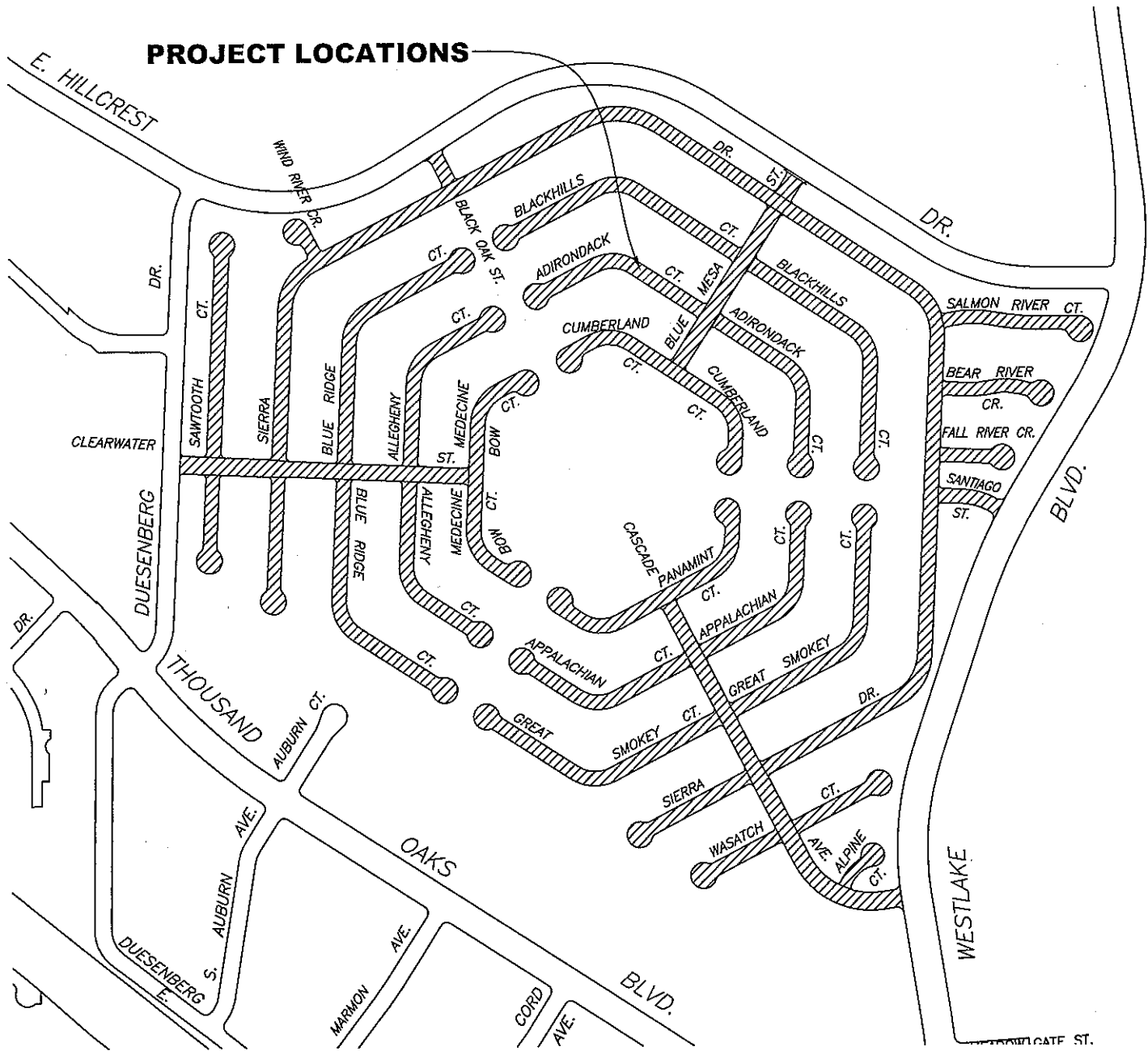

SUBJECT: **Business Roundtable Appointments**

RECOMMENDATION:

Approve the re-appointments of Dan Overton and Ashish Vaidya, and the appointments of Robert Bianchi, Betsy Friedman, and Larry Horner to the Business Roundtable to serve two-year terms ending April 2012.

FINANCIAL IMPACT:

No additional funding requested. Staff time for costs associated with coordinating interviews, appointments and preparing support materials.

BACKGROUND:

The 11 member Business Roundtable serves as an advisory body to the City Council relative to local business community. One-half of the membership is appointed annually by City Council. An open application period for the current vacancies closed March 24, 2010.

DISCUSSION/ANALYSIS:

Fourteen residents submitted applications for five vacancies; however, two incumbents withdrew their applications, and two did not show up for the scheduled interview. Interviews of ten applicants were conducted on April 22, 2010, and one interview was conducted on April 25, 2010. Following careful consideration of all applications, the following re-appointments to the Business Roundtable are recommended: Dan Overton and Ashish Vaidya. As well, the following appointments are recommended: Robert Bianchi, Betsy Friedman, and Larry Horner.


COUNCIL GOAL COMPLIANCE:
